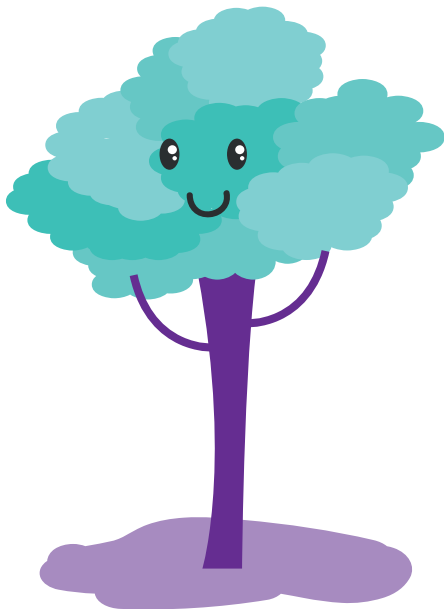
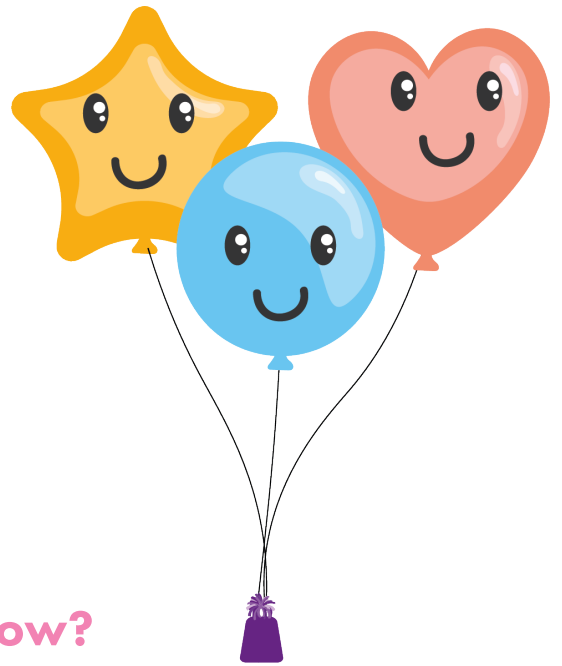


Foil and Latex Balloons

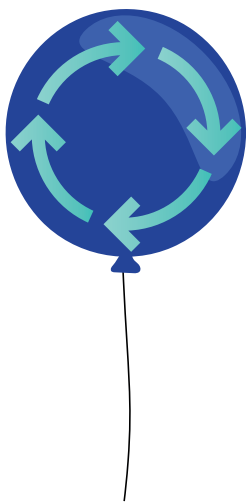
Did you know?

Latex balloons are made from natural latex also known as rubber. This raw material is obtained from the rubber tree. The rubber trees do a great job at filtering CO₂ from the air, helping us reduce pollution.

Latex balloons are biodegradable, latex itself is a renewable raw material and the trees are not hurt in the extraction process (rubber tapping).

Our latex balloons have an excellent helium and air retention, due to a sophisticated molecular cross-link which creates a high-quality barrier, reducing gas permeability. They also fulfill the highest safety and quality standards.

Our foil balloons are reusable. The easiest way to deflate the balloons is by inserting a small tube at least 7 cm into the balloon and pressing gently. And not to mention we prioritize air filled vs. helium, which means that the balloons are less likely to float away and end up in the environment.

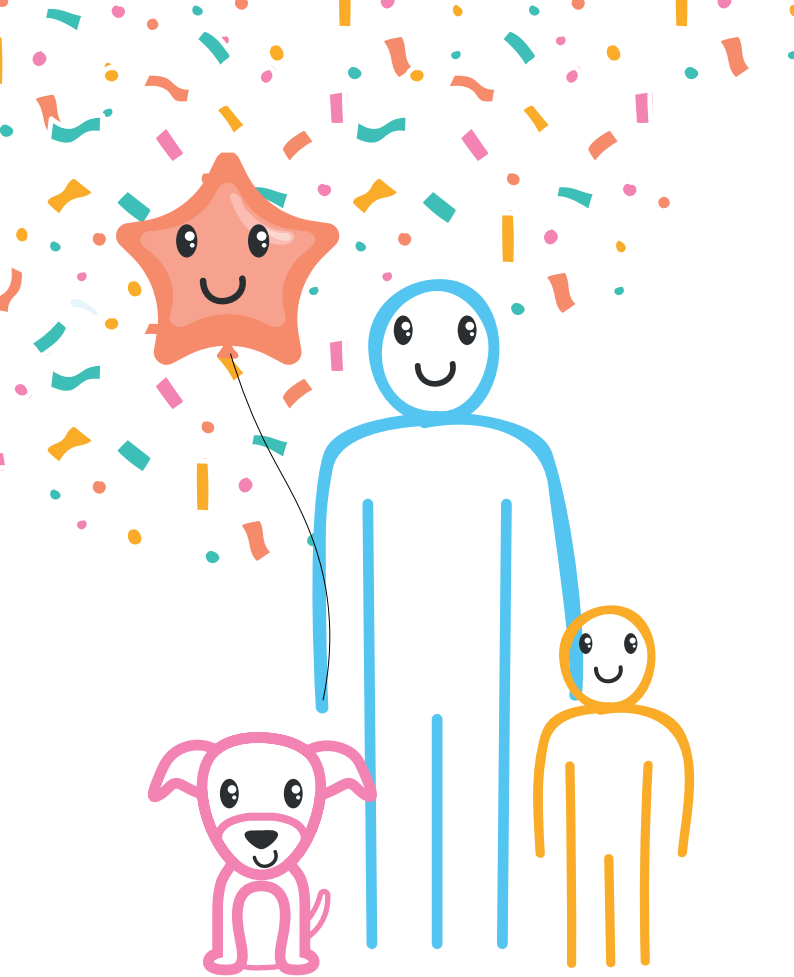

What can you do?

Supervise small children and pets when celebrating with balloons and always pick up broken latex balloons immediately, as they can be dangerous for children under 8 years and pets.

Be mindful of allergies. As all our latex balloons are 100% natural rubber latex, they may cause an allergic reaction to some people. Always use a pump to inflate.

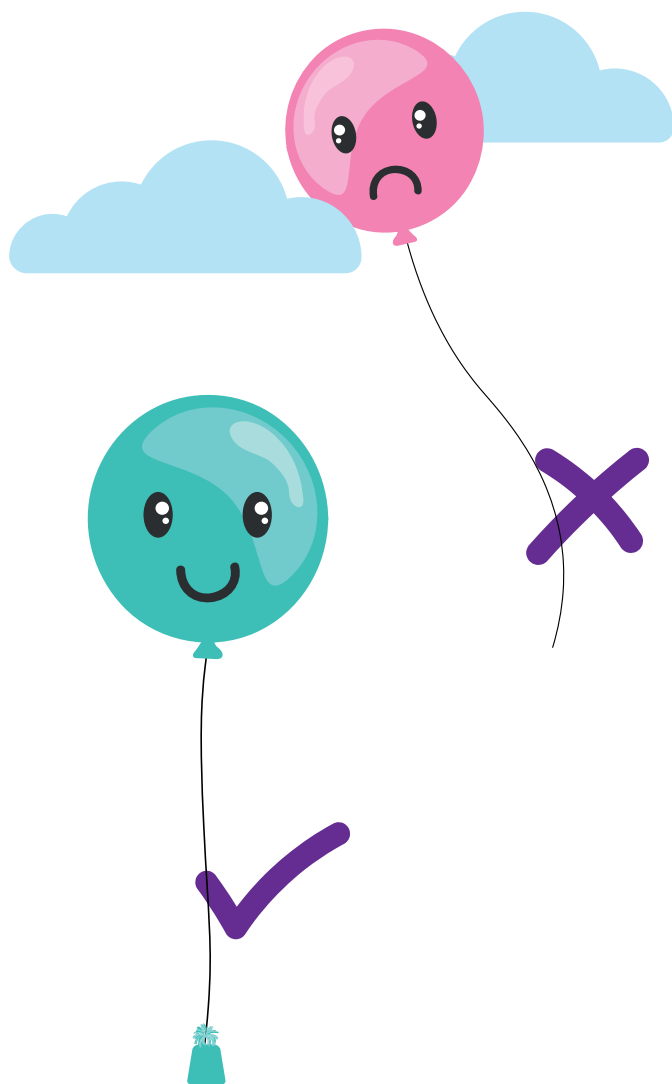
Refill and re-use foil balloons when possible. We guarantee the quality will stay the same every time.

... Do not release balloons outdoors, always properly tie them, or use a balloon weight. Balloons do not belong in nature.

Always dispose of your balloons responsibly. If you are unsure about the correct disposal route, check with your local authorities.

Teach children to pick up after themselves, especially after a fun water balloon fight.

Find fun and creative ways to repurpose used balloons or balloon scraps in DIY projects.
